Owners who donate services, along with the corresponding purchaser of the fee, will have the privilege of participation in the Breeders Challenge Futurity, subject to the rules and conditions. The stallion owner agrees to file a stallion report with the POAC, Inc. for the actual breeding year.

Mare Owner: The mare owner agrees to purchase the above breeding service from the Breeders Challenge Futurity Auction. The purchase price of \$ _____ will be paid to the Breeders Challenge Auction and will entitle mare owner to one breeding. The payment will be accepted in full by cash/check at the time of the Auction, or with a 25% down payment followed by three equal monthly payment installments due on the 20th of each month, or credit card on the day of the auction. All remaining stallion fees are due in full by July 1st, 2025 or any breeding and payments made are forfeited to the BCF and the stallion owner will be eligible to purchase both stallion & mare owner entries by submitting all monies due.

At the time of purchase the mare owner will sign all copies of the agreement – one will be retained by the mare owner, one by the BCF Secretary, and one will be sent to stallion owner as proof of service sold and mare owner information. It is the mare owner's responsibility to verify transported semen arrangements before the auction. Credit will only be issued in the event of death of the stallion, stallion being unserviceable (veterinary statement), stallion owner, manager or lessee refusing to honor contract for any reason, or the stallion is moved to an undesirable location after the auction. All stallion fees and contracts purchased must be paid up in good standing on all Breeders Challenge Auction contracts to maintain eligibility to show in this futurity. The rule sheets are available from the Breeders Challenge Futurity President.

The stallion fee is due in full by July 1st of the year purchased. The stallion owner has the right on July 31st of year sold to pay unpaid balance to maintain their stallion eligibility and would have two entries. The purchaser would forfeit their right to an entry.
